This event is a clubsport advanced sealed hillclimb promoted by the Wanganui Car Club Inc. It will take place on Sunday 2nd December 2018 at Brunswick road Wanganui It will be held under the current motorsport New Zealand National sporting code and its appendices and schedules. The permit is for a clubsport advanced Hillclimb. The road will be closed under the Transport Act 1965.

VENUE

Brunswick Road – Hillclimb starts flat before crossing a narrow bridge followed by a tight hairpin before climbing and opening up to high speed corners and flattening out over the top to a high-speed finish. Approx 2.5kms up from the Wanganui River Brunswick Rd intersection.

REFUNDS

Any competitor that requires a refund of their entry fee must officially notify the event secretary of their withdrawal prior to the completion of documentation.. No refunds will be available if we are not officially notified by the completion of documentation.

COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS

In signing the entry form, competitors are deemed to fully understand the supplementary regulations and all relevant articles and regulations as contained in the Motorsport New Zealand Manual. Passengers will be allowed, but must sign the motorsport passenger indemnity form and the car and passengers must meet all requirements of Schedule A for passengers.

LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

The driver must hold a minimum of a Motorsport New Zealand clubsport (M grade) license or higher, have a current civil driver's license and also be a financial member of an affiliated car club of NZ. All licenses, log books and relevant paperwork are to be produced at Documentation.

DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING

We will NOT be holding documentation or Scrutineering on Friday night this year.

Sunday 2nd December from 7.30 – 8.45 am at Brunswick road competitors will be required to attend.

DRIVERS BRIEFING

Drivers briefing will be held at the venue at **9:00 am. This is compulsory for all competitors.**

All cars will be required to run Wanganui Car Club laminated number cards in their side windows, these numbers will be issued at drivers briefing and to be returned at completion of your weekends racing.

PASSENGERS

Passengers are only allowed in cars with roll cages that have been scrutineered to take passengers. Passengers will be permitted on all runs so long as they have signed the indemnity form prior located at the caravan, this is the Drivers responsibility to check. Drivers are required to ensure all passengers wear safety equipment in accordance with Schedule A, which must also be available for inspection at scrutineering.

RESULTS

We plan on a drive thru sighting run ,1 x practice and up to 4 official runs time permitting. One complete timed official run will be deemed sufficient for a result to be declared. Results will be taken from all completed runs at the discretion of the organizing committee, their decision is final. Unofficial running results will be available throughout the day.

Final official results will be available at the prize giving venues at the completion of the event.
Event certificates will be issued at the prizegiving at the car club rooms after the event

PRIZE GIVING

Prize giving will be held following the event at the Wanganui Car Club Clubrooms, Airport Road, Wanganui

DAMAGE

Although MSNZ Public Liability Insurance will cover the event, all claims have an excess of \$3,500.00. Therefore competitors will be responsible for any damage they cause to public or private property and will be liable for the cost of repairs, up to the value of this excess.

PROTESTS

Protests shall be in accordance with the National Sporting Code and directed to the Clerk of Course on the day

BEHAVIOUR

During the event no competition car will be allowed to leave the venue (past the road closure barriers) without the permission of the Clerk of the Course. Previous issues with competitors warming tyres and brakes outside the venue have led to complaints from residents. Failure to comply with behavior requirements may result in exclusion or other penalty as determined by the Clerk of the Course.

PRE-EVENT RECONNAISSANCE

Competitors are requested to refrain from familiarizing themselves with the course prior to the event, and to drive considerately to and from the event. Concern has been expressed by the Residents of our hillclimbs to the Organizers as to people and or vehicles driving the road before the event.

THIS WILL NOT BE TOLERATED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.

Residents have been advised to take the plate numbers of all cars that are not known to be residents of this area. These will be investigated and you may be excluded from the event if you do not have permission from the organizing committee, **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

GENERAL

Check the Wanganui Car Club facebook page for updates, please note there are 2 different facebook pages.

In the case of dual drivers in one car, entries may be accepted on the condition the organizers cannot guarantee that either driver will complete all their runs. Please note dual drivers on your entry.

Depending on the weather we hope to have a Pit Paddock available both days, please check on arrival at each venue to find out where to park.

The organizers reserve the right to cancel or alter the running of the event at any time.

Wanganui Car Club Rules for Classic Cars

- First year of manufacture of model range must be prior to 1980
- Induction method to be original
- Engine ignition management and fuel management systems are free
- Brakes are free
- Suspension free, except that pick-up points must be original
- Gearbox and differential are free, sequential gearboxes not allowed
- Wheel are free provided that the wheel diameter is not more than 2 inches greater than original
- Engine must have been available in the model range
- No c.c. rating classes
